What do I bring if I haven't done my taxes yet?

- SS cards for student and parent(s)
- Last year-end pay stub received in December 2011 by you and your parents, showing year-to-date earnings
- 2010 tax forms for both student and parent(s)
- 2011 statements of interest earned

What is FAFSA Frenzy?

FAFSA Frenzy, a program of [College Goal SundaySM](#), is offered in Missouri through partnerships between the Missouri Department of Higher Education (MDHE) with the [Missouri Association of Student Financial Aid Personnel \(MASFAP\)](#), the [Lumina Foundation for Education](#), and the [YMCA](#) to assist students and families in completing the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). The [College Goal SundaySM](#) program was created by the Indiana Student Financial Aid Association (ISFAA) with funding from Lilly Endowment, Inc., and with supplemental support from the Lumina Foundation for Education. South Technical High School and Ranken Technical College have partnered to offer this event to St. Louis area students.

The FAFSA is the primary application used by [federal](#), state, and institutional financial assistance entities in determining an individual's eligibility for [grants](#), [loans](#), work-study, and [scholarships](#).
